There are over 490,000 Pensioners living in the EU who receive a UK State Pension, and the annual increase that goes with it. Because of Brexit negotiations, they may lose this annual increase. According to The Telegraph, over a 20 year period a UK pensioner will be £50,000 poorer as a result.
